- 5. Why do you think it's important to forgive with urgency, as highlighted by the warning to not let the sun go down on our anger?
- 6. What does it mean to forgive "from your heart" as opposed to simply excusing or tolerating an offense?
- 7. What are some misconceptions about forgiveness that you've struggled with, such as the idea of "forgetting" or "surrendering all justice"?
- 8. How can looking to the Cross help you relinquish offenses and genuinely forgive others?
